

## BUMP Mission

From its beginning as a ministry of the church in 1970, Bethelview United Methodist Pre-school's half day Christian program has been committed to the growth and success of each student. Our educational philosophy stresses the needs of the "whole student" – personal and spiritual development, as well as academic excellence. The essence of our mission is found in Proverbs 22:6: "Train up a child in the way he should go and when he is old he will not depart from it."

We recognize each student as an individual with individual gifts. Learning capacity is based in part upon growth and maturity, but also upon differences in learning styles. Consequently, we focus on learning experiences appropriate not only to age, but also to maturity and learning style. We promote creativity,



critical thinking, and curiosity. We strive for the development of leadership capabilities and a sense of personal responsibility. We help our students develop self-discipline, practical compassion for others and appreciation of diversity. We instill the positive attitudes necessary for school success.

## BUMP Staff

Our BUMP Staff is made up of competent and trained individuals dedicated to offering an excellent early childhood program. Standards are maintained yearly as all staff members are required to attend workshops, seminars and in-service training. Our staff is trained in Child CPR, First Aide and Fire Safety. All staff members have obtained background checks prior to being employed.

## BUMP Classes

BUMP offers classes to children from the age of 12 months through five years of age. **Applicants for all classes must attain the class age by September 1st of the school year.** We follow the Forsyth County School's calendar with the exception of the start and end date.



## BUMP Curriculum

**MMO (aka Ones)** uses the *A Beka* toddler curriculum which is developed around themes that provide opportunities for children to learn about God's world and how to live in it. The themes are designed to help lay a foundation for understanding God, Bible, church, self, family, others and community and world through play and interaction.

**Twos and Threes** use the *A Beka* preschool curriculum. These lessons integrate developmentally appropriate activities in math, art and language with religious development. The lesson plans are organized around seasonal themes with weekly lesson plans.

**Pre-K (4's and young 5's)** incorporates the *A Beka* 4 Year Old Kindergarten Curriculum into a program that has been specifically designed to prepare this age group for kindergarten in public or private school. Students are given a solid learning foundation in phonics, writing, math and Bible in a rich learning environment.

\*Tuition is divided into monthly payments and is due the first of each month. If you enroll more than one child at BUMP, your second and subsequent children will receive \$10 off their monthly tuition.

\*\*Activity, Snack and Registration Fee is charged once each school year. Registration Fee is non-refundable.

## BUMP Enrollment

Registration forms are available from the pre-school office, preschool website or can be requested via email.

Enrollment opens in January, first to BUMC Members and then currently enrolled BUMP families. After these groups have had the opportunity to register, registration is opened to the public at the end of January and is then conducted on a first come first serve basis.

If space is available and child is accepted into our pre-school, parents will pay the appropriate non-refundable registration fee and the child is then placed in the appropriate class.
