The Music Teacher develops, implements, and evaluates engaging lesson plans tailored to the following age groups:

- Mommy's Morning Out (MMO): 12 months – 2 years
- Two-Year-Olds: 2 – 3 years
- Preschool Threes: 3 – 4 years
- Pre-Kindergarten: 4 – 5 years

Key Responsibilities

- Spiritual & Musical Instruction
- Teach foundational musical concepts and terminology in age-appropriate ways.
- Integrate Christian values and Biblical truths into music instruction.
- Select and teach Christ-centered songs for school-wide performances.
- Prepare students for annual musical programs, including Fall, Christmas, Easter, End of Year and Graduation celebrations.

- Develop and implement engaging, developmentally appropriate lesson plans.
- Encourage fine and gross motor skill development through movement activities and age-appropriate instruments.
- Create a joyful and inclusive learning environment that supports creativity and participation.
- Classroom & Program Management
- Maintain a clean, organized, and welcoming music classroom.
- Decorate the music room in alignment with seasons and program themes.
- Provide firm, loving classroom management with a positive and cheerful disposition.

Professional Responsibilities

- Attend all monthly staff meetings.
- Participate in required staff training and certifications.
- Attend occasional dress rehearsals scheduled on Mondays or Wednesdays.
- Collaborate with staff to support the overall mission and ministry of the preschool.
